AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ONEKAMA TOWNSHIP ROAD END ORDINANCE DATED OCTOBER 31, 1990, BY ENUMERATING AN ADDITIONAL PURPOSE FOR THE ORDINANCE; BY DELETING CERTAIN ENFORCEMENT REMEDIES; AND BY MAKING OTHER TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS THERTO.

The Township of Onekama hereby ORDAINS:

Section 1

Section 1- Purpose, of the Onekama Township Road End Ordinance dated October 31, 1990, ("Ordinance") is hereby amended by the addition of the following:

To exercise governmental police powers with respect to all platted, Township owned riparian road ends for the purpose of evidencing the Township's acceptance of the dedications of these road ends and enjoyment of the public.

Section 2

Section 7 - General Use, paragraph B, of the Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the footnote at the end of the paragraph.

Section 3

Section - 8 Penalties and/or Enforcement of Ordinance, is hereby amended by deleting paragraph B thereof in its entirety

Section 4

This Amending Ordinance shall become effective upon publication as required by law.
